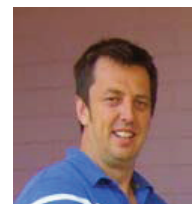

48% of Australian pastors will reach retirement age in 12 years! The Presbyterian church of Victoria estimates that 64 out of its 104 churches will be without a pastor by 2021. 19 Sydney Anglican parishes are seeking a senior pastor. These figures give serious concern at the future shortages of fully trained ministers and the big hole that will be left when current ministers retire, which is evidenced by ACF members when travelling around Australia.
